- 2) What are the ways that we comprehend the love of Christ?
  - a) What does it mean to be "rooted and grounded in love"?
  - b) How is His love evident in our lives and through difficult times?
  
- 3) Paul says in verse 21, "to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations." How can we, as the church and as one body, glorify Him in this time of separation and distancing?
  
- 4) How often do we find ourselves, maybe even subconsciously, not living in a manner where verse 20 is true?
  - a) What can tend to tempt us away from living in this truth?
  - b) How can we continually remind ourselves that God's power is beyond sufficient?
  
- 5) Knowing that the same power that was at work in Paul through his ministry is at work in us, what should that spur us on to do?
